announces a call for applications for a position of
ASSISTANT PROFESSOR (in Polish terminology *ADIUNKT*)
in the Faculty of Philosophy
Department of Logic
with an area of specialization in mathematical logic

Candidates should have a substantial record of publication in the area of mathematical logic.

Applicants have to fulfill requirements of art. 109 of a statute from 27.07.2005 concerning Laws of higher education (Dz. U. nr 164, poz. 1365, z późn. zm.) and fulfill the following criteria:

- have an appropriate degree from an accredited institution,
- positive reviews of doctoral or habilitation work,
- adequate scholarly output such as a doctoral dissertation and related publications,
- active participation in scholarly life, including participation in conferences and symposia,
- positive recommendation from the chair of the department/institute/cathedral with which they are currently affiliated or a positive recommendation from their academic mentor/adviser about their qualification and potential to engage in scholarly and pedagogical work on a university level; in case the candidate is not habilitated, this recommendation should include an opinion regarding prospects of achieving habilitation,
- ability to independently create and lead courses at a university level, which is verified with a recommendation from the chair of the department/institute/cathedral with which the candidate is affiliated or, in case the candidate is not yet habilitated, with a recommendation from an adviser or mentor.

Candidates responding to this call have to deposit the following documents in Dziekanat Wydziału Filozoficznego UJ (Dean of the Faculty of Philosophy), Kraków, ul. Gołębia 24 room 24:

- 1) application,
- 2) academic CV,
- 3) personal survey,
- 4) a copy of doctoral or habilitation diploma; with a notarized translation, if from a university outside of Poland,
- 5) a letter of motivation that highlights the candidates most important research goals and achievements,
- 6) list of publications (including publisher and the number of pages),
- 7) list of courses taught,
- 8) a filled-out survey about research activities,
- 9) a filled-out survey about teaching activities, and if the candidate's teaching was reviewed, such reviews, along with any extant student surveys
- 10) review of doctoral dissertation or habilitation,
- 11) recommendation from chair/director or from a mentor/adviser,
- 12) proof of proficiency in one non-Polish language,
- 13) signed declaration that Jagiellonian University will be the primary place of employment, in case the candidate is selected for the position and decides to take up the position offered,
- 14) signed declaration of compliance with art. 109 ust. 1 of statute regarding Laws of higher education.
- 15) signed declaration of agreement to being counted as a member of the faculty minimum required by law to grant rights to award doctoral degrees and habilitations and/or for the purposes of creating courses of study, in case the candidate is selected and accepts the position offered.
- 16) signed declaration of being knowledgeable about and accepting of rules governing intellectual property and the legal protection awarded to intellectual property.

The deadline for submitting application is August 2nd, 2016.

The decisions will be announced September 22nd, 2016.
